Kyneton Pannoobamawm and Bendigo, Farming and grazing, Shire Councillor of Echuca for 12

years, and Justice of Peace, went to Bendigo in 1880, Founded the John Watson & Company stockstation and finance. Closer settlement, bought land at Panoobamawm on 27th February 1911. 9189 acres at £6- 8- 6d per acre old home shifted it to Kotta by a Mr. Monsanto and renovated from panoobamawm John died aged 64 years due to peritonitis.

It is said he had two Funerals, First in Methodist Chapel and then in Parish Church, after which he was laid to rest in churchyard with his wife Grace who went before him beside his father John and Grandfather William

His Gravestone is on the right hand side as you enter churchyard beside the two big Fir trees
